Aims to support First Nation Citizens who self-identify as living with a disability (Disability is defined as developmental, intellectual, physical or other including addictions or mental health concerns).

- Legally able to work in Canada.
- AETS First Nation Citizen are given priority.
- Disabled (Disability is defined as any developmental, intellectual, physical or other including addictions or mental health)
