Eligibility

- AETS First Nation citizens are given priority
- Must be legally able to work in Canada
- Has a disability (developmental, intellectual, physical or other including addictions or mental health concerns)



Key outcomes for **individuals** include gaining the tools, skills, and information to obtain employment, become employed or self employed.

Key outcomes for **employers** include increased ability to hire, retain, and support persons with disabilities in the workplace.
